## DOWNTOWN OMAHA TO WELCOME 2018 WITH 'GIRLS WHO ROCK'-THEMED FIREWORKS SPECTACULAR PRESENTED BY T-MOBILE

Region's Largest New Year's Eve Fireworks Display Sets Off at Family-Friendly Time

Nov. 9, 2017 - The Holiday Lights Festival's New Year's Eve Fireworks Spectacular, presented by T-Mobile, will fill the sky with colorful bursts of light on New Year's Eve, Sunday, Dec. 31, starting at the family-friendly hour of 7 p.m. The official viewing will be at the Gene Leahy Mall at 14th and Farnam Streets with the show visible for miles.
